

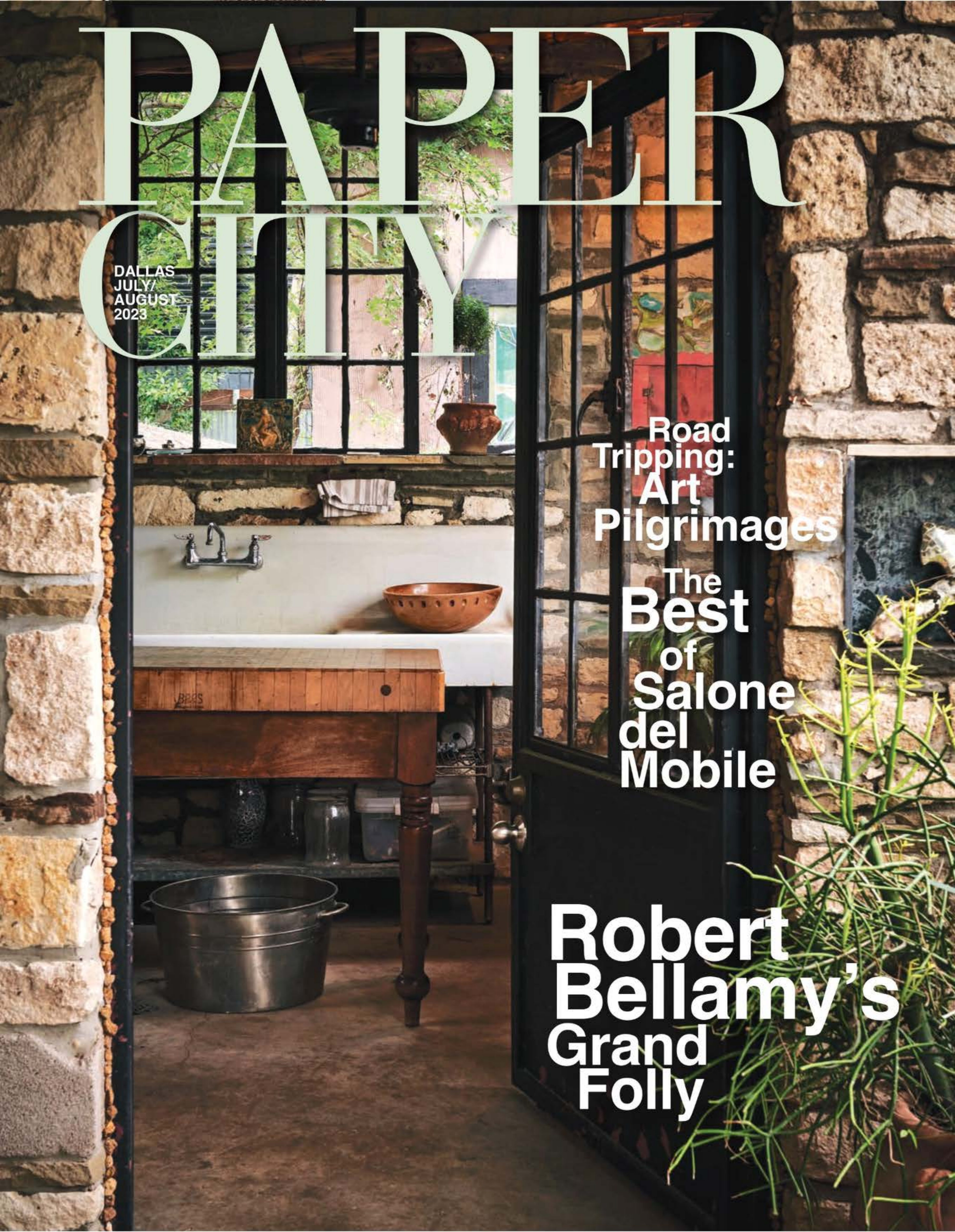

PaperCity is now accepting entries for the **2023 Dallas PaperCity Design Awards**, which recognizes outstanding interior design; interior architecture; retail, restaurant, and gallery design; landscape design; historical preservation; and furniture, product, and textile design, along with other categories.

The *PaperCity* Design Awards is open to all Dallas-Fort Worth-area interior designers, architects, landscape designers, and product, furniture and textile

designers, regardless of professional affiliation. All are encouraged to enter projects across 20 categories. Deadline to enter is Wednesday, October 11. SUMMER ON THE SAVANNA

An heirloom chair and stool by Ethiopian

American artist and industrial designer **Jomo Tariku** — a pioneer of modern African design — has just been acquired by the **Dallas Museum of Art**. The **Nyala** chair, made of ebonized ash, is inspired by the distinctive horns, hind legs, and white spots of the Nyala antelope, which is native to the Bale region in the Ethiopian highlands of East Africa, where the designer grew up. The **Mukecha** stool/table references traditional African mortars and pestles, and its colorful banding is influenced by neck rings adorning bronze busts from The Kingdom of Benin. Tariku, who studied industrial design in the U.S., has works in museums around the country, including The Metropolitan Museum of Art.
